

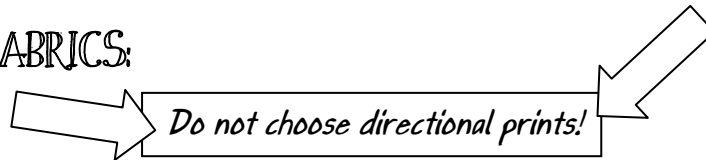
# ARE YOU CEREAL?

## Fabric Requirements, Pre-Cutting and Pre-Sewing

### NEED TO KNOW:

- ✦ Quilt will finish approximately 54x66".
- ✦ C1 - Color 1, C2 - Color 2, C3 - Color 3.
- ✦ WOF = Width of Fabric (selvage to selvage).
- ✦ Fabric is 40" wide without selvages.
- ✦ You'll need 3 bags or other receptacles to contain the cut fabrics. As you cut, put the pieces in different bags as instructed.
- ✦ Mark or lightly press the diagonal on the wrong side of *ALL* 3½" squares.

### CHOOSING YOUR FABRICS:



- ✦ C1 is Light - or you can think of it as Background, as long as it's not directional.
- ✦ C2 is Medium, C3 is Dark.
- ✦ C1, C2 and C3 can be different shades of the same color.
- ✦ C2 would work well with a BUSY print (again, NOT directional).
- ✦ C3 would work well as a LARGE print (no, this can't be directional, either!).

### YARDAGE:

- ✦ C1 2\* yards
  - ✦ C2 1 yard
  - ✦ C3 1¼ yards
- \* No wiggle room for mistakes!

### PRE-CUTTING:

\*\*\*Cut fabrics in the order listed.\*\*\*

*The instructions may look strange, but they're written this way to use as little fabric as possible. If you choose to cut in a different order, be sure to purchase additional fabric AND double- and triple-check your bag list at the end.*

- C1**  
Cut 1 - 3½" x WOF strip  
Cut this strip into 8 - 3½" squares. Put 4 into Lucky Charms bag, 4 into Frosted Flakes bag.
- Cut 6 - 6½" x WOF strips  
Cut into 30 - 6½" squares. Put 16 into Lucky Charms, 4 into Mini Wheats, 10 into Frosted Flakes.
- Cut 3 - 9½" strips  
From one strip, cut 4 - 6½ x 9½" rectangles. Put 2 into Lucky Charms, 2 into Frosted Flakes.  
From two strips, cut 8 - 9½" squares. Put 4 into Lucky Charms, 4 into Frosted Flakes.

**C2**

Cut 6 - 3½" WOF strips

Cut into 60 - 3½" squares. Put 32 into Lucky Charms, 8 into Mini Wheats, 20 into Frosted Flakes.

Cut 2 - 6½" x WOF strips

Cut into 12 - 6½" squares. Put 6 into Lucky Charms, 2 into Mini Wheats, 4 into Frosted Flakes.

**C3**

Cut 1 - 3½" x WOF strips

Cut into 11 - 3½" squares. Put 10 into Lucky Charms, 1 into Frosted Flakes.

Cut 3 - 6½" x WOF strips

Cut into 9 - 6½" squares. Put 4 into Lucky Charms, 3 into Mini Wheats, 2 into Frosted Flakes.

Cut 4 - 6½ x 9½" rectangles. Put 2 into Lucky Charms, 2 into Frosted Flakes.

Cut the remainder of the last 6½" strip into a 3½" strip.

Cut 9 - 3½" squares. Put into Frosted Flakes.

Cut 2 - 9½" strips

Cut into 8 - 9½" squares. Put 4 into Lucky Charms, 4 into Frosted Flakes.

**BAG CHECK:**

- Lucky Charms: 4 - 3½" squares C1.....
- 16 - 6½" squares C1.....
- 2 - 6½ x 9½" rectangles C1.....
- 4 - 9½" squares C1.....
- 32 - 3½" squares C2.....
- 6 - 6½" squares C2.....
- 10 - 3½" squares C3.....
- 2 - 6½" squares C3.....
- 2 - 6½ x 9½" rectangles C3.....
- 4 - 9½" squares C3.....



- Mini Wheats: 4 - 6½" squares C1.....
- 8 - 3½" squares C2.....
- 2 - 6½" squares C2.....
- 3 - 6½" squares C3.....



- Frosted Flakes: 4 - 3½" squares C1.....
- 10 - 6½" squares C1.....
- 2 - 6½ x 9½" rectangles C1.....
- 4 - 9½" squares C1.....
- 20 - 3½" squares C2.....
- 4 - 6½" squares C2.....
- 10 - 3½" squares C3.....
- 2 - 6½" squares C3.....
- 2 - 6½ x 9½" rectangles C3.....
- 4 - 9½" squares C3.....



# ARE YOU CEREAL?

JUST FOR



If you have the time and inclination, you can do a little bit of sewing before class. Do all of the steps, do some of the steps, or skip it all together. This is completely optional!

## NEED TO KNOW:

- ✦ Now that you've cut all of your shapes, you have a bunch of  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares,  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares,  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and  $6\frac{1}{2} \times 9\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. It's time to simplify: we're going to call these
  - small squares
  - medium squares
  - large squares AND (wait for it....!)
  - rectangles

\*\*\*Return the sewn units to the bag you pulled the pieces from\*\*\*

✓	Take From This Bag	Do This
	Mini Wheats	Stitch & flip a small C2 square to one corner of medium C1. Press & trim the triangle, then sew another small square to an adjacent corner of the square to make a <b>SPECIAL K</b> block. <b>Make 1.</b>
	Lucky Charms	Make 12 Special K blocks.
	Frosted Flakes	Make 8 Special K blocks.



*What? You want MORE?*

	Lucky Charms	Sew the short end of a C1 rectangle to the short end a C3 rectangle. Make 2.
	Frosted Flakes	Sew the short end of a C1 rectangle to the short end a C3 rectangle. Make 2.
